# FAQ

#### How do I start?

Just get some friends together and play, collect a small amount from each player for the street kids and donate using: www.justgiving.com/StreetSoccer-Lausanne

# How much do we donate?

Aim for at least CHF 1 per player per game.

# How do I find other teams to play against?

Firstly, get a team together based on the following leagues:

Kids under 13 (boys and minimum 3 girls)

Boys under 10
Boys under 12
Boys under 14
Boys under 16
Girls under 14
Girls under 16

Men Women Family and Friends (for all)

Next, think of a name for the team, anything you want.

#### Team Official, what does this mean?

Each team needs an official to:

- Arrange games with other teams in the same league
- Setup the pitch
- Referee home games unless delegated to someone else
- Collect donations and donate using:

#### Team home pitch, what if we don't have a team pitch?

No problem, the idea of street soccer is that it is easy, no need to hire a pitch. The main format is Soccer7s which just requires a public park and use training markers and cones for goal posts. Just put the name of the public park as the home team pitch.

# Team home shirt, do we need to have a team kit?

No need to buy a team kit unless you want to. Just pick a shirt colour for the team and make sure they match. For the away shirt, every team should also have a white shirt that matches. If there is a clash, the home team decide which shirts to use.

#### Format, which format?

We will use the Soccer7s format. Here is a description of the different formats:

#### **Street**

4-a-side, rules: regular rules apply, except; 1. no offsides, 2. free-kick wall 4 paces from ball.

7 mins per half

Pitch: KickAbout 4s - made using training markers and cones for the goal posts,

or if lucky to find a real pitch with similar dimensions:

28 paces long, markers every 4 paces.

21 paces wide.

goals 5 paces wide, using cones for goal posts.

penalty area defined by the markers near the goal and 4 paces along the touchline.

penalty spot 8 paces from the middle of the goal.

#### Soccer5s

5-a-side, rules: regular rules apply, except; 1. no offsides, 2. free-kick wall 5 paces from ball.

7 mins per half

Pitch: KickAbout 5s - made using training markers and cones for the goal posts,

or if lucky to find a real pitch with similar dimensions:

35 paces long, markers every 5 paces.

25 paces wide.

goals 6 paces wide, using cones for goal posts.

penalty area defined by the markers near the goal and 5 paces along the touchline.

penalty spot 8 paces from the middle of the goal.

#### Soccer7s

7-a-side, rules: regular rules apply, except free-kick wall 8 paces from ball.

7 mins per half

Pitch: KickAbout 7s - made using training markers and cones for the goal posts,

or if lucky to find a real pitch with similar dimensions:

56 paces long, markers every 8 paces.

32 paces wide.

goals 6 paces wide, using cones for goal posts.

penalty area defined by the markers near the goal and 8 paces along the touchline.

penalty spot 8 paces from the middle of the goal.

#### Soccer11s

11-a-side

14 mins per half

Pitch: Full size or Junior size (for boys and girls)

Home team, what if we are using the same home pitch? Just alternate the home team on the match reports. This is required for the league table.

#### How many games do we play?

Play as many games as you want, just make sure to donate for each game.

# How does the league work?

Firstly, there is no restriction on the number of games to play. Each team should play each other team at least twice, home and away if possible.

The points will be awarded based on the best home and away results against each of the other teams.

Best Results Table, points system:

```
win = 3 points
draw = 1 point
goal scored = 1 point
goal against = -1 point
```

We will also keep track of the donations from each team in the Donations Table.

#### How long is the season?

Spring Mar Apr May
Summer Jun Jul Aug
Autumn Sep Oct Nov

Games played in the 3 months of the season will count, we will have league champions for each season.

# What if we play a team many times?

Again, there is no restriction, just make sure to donate for each game. For the league, the best home and away results will be used to determine the points awarded.
